GP Appointments

We run a total triage system for all new GP appointments. All requests for new appointments must be made via completion of a form. This can be completed online by the patient or by one of our Receptionists if the patient rings the surgery. The forms open at 8 am on working days and are closed when capacity is reached.

Appointments with the nursing team are made by telephoning the surgery.

Patient Involvement

The practice runs a patient participation group and the door is always open for new members. Please see a member of staff if you are interested or register your interest via our virtual surgery.

Accountable GP

All of our patients have been allocated a named, accountable GP at the practice. This does not affect your wishes to see your preferred GP.

Practice Area

Due to the enormous increase in housing and the lack of plans by local councils/CCG to provide extra local medical provision, we regret that we can now only accept new patients living in Mossley (OL5 postcode) or Greenfield (OL3 postcode).

Accessibility

Both surgeries are accessible to wheelchair users. There is an accessible toilet at both sites.

Home Visits

Home visits will ONLY be offered if you are strictly housebound, terminally ill, or the visit is deemed appropriate by the GP. If you require a home visit, telephone 01457 832590/833922 before 10.30am. The reception staff will ask for information to help the doctor assess the urgency of the request. Home visits should not be requested due to lack of transport or bad weather conditions.

PLEASE DO NOT ASK FOR A VISIT IF YOU ARE CAPABLE OF ATTENDING THE SURGERY.

Emergencies

If you need to contact the doctor outside surgery hours, telephone 01457 832590 and you will be transferred to the deputising service. A doctor will speak to you and you will be asked either to attend the out-of-hours centre or a doctor will call to see you.

Repeat Prescriptions

To order repeat medication you can:

- 1. Telephone 01457 835345 (answering machine) anytime
- 2. Bring your slip into surgery clearly marked with the items you require
- 3. Order online via Patient Access (you will need to register with this service first)
- 4. Order on line via our virtual surgery

Please note:

- allow 48 hours for your prescription to be processed before collection
- Do not order repeat medication earlier than 7 days prior to the due date

The surgery will not tolerate violence or aggression towards members of staff. In such instances the patient will be removed from the register with immediate effect.
